Three new books by the end of the year

With *The Humboldt Brothers. Stories from the Present*, the fifth publication of the Humboldt Forum short guides has been published by Prestel Verlag. Also just released: the book Contemporary Art in the Humboldt Forum.

Initiated by a burning museum in Brazil, the *Das Museum Sem Nenhum Caráter* project spanned over two years in cooperation with the Museu Nacional and the Goethe-Institut Rio de Janeiro. The free digital publication explores questions surrounding decolonial curatorial practices.

Wilhelm and Alexander von Humboldt are the namesakes of the Humboldt Forum. The brothers' biographies, works and points of view build a compelling relationship with the prominent cultural site in the heart of Berlin.

This book is dedicated to the Humboldt brothers' travels, their studies of nature and language, and their cosmopolitan curiosity, linked to the present not least by their insights into the interconnected world.

Contemporary Art in the Humboldt Forum

A Japanese tea house, an audio installation with sounds of Nigeria, a two-part flag-pole made of bronze: numerous, often large-scale works of contemporary art can be discovered throughout the spacious displays at Berlin's Humboldt Forum. Works by artists from different cultures around the world enrich the collections shown in the exhibitions of the Ethnologisches Museum, Museum für Asiatische Kunst, and the Federal State of Berlin. In addition, seven works of Kunst am Bau (art in architec-ture) have been realised at the Humboldt Forum. They address the location's history and the Humboldt Forum as a site representing the world, encouraging encounters and exchange, or paying tribute to the Forum's namesakes, the brothers Wilhelm and Alexander von Humboldt.

This book presents selected works of art in informative, richly associative texts and impressive photographs. Together they offer entirely new insights into the diverse voices that make up the Humboldt Forum cultural venue.

Das Museum Sem Nenhum Caráter - Resisting the Universal

The project's initiation resulted from the tragic fire, which almost entirely devastated the Museu Nacional de Rio de Janeiro's collection and building. With some 20 million objects, the collection is one of the most important in Latin America and the world, with the loss including perhaps the last testimonies, in the form of artefacts or language records, of the numerous Indigenous communities in Brazil. The collaborative project Das Museum Sem Nenhum Caráter took its inspiration from the novel Macunaíma: O herói sem nenhum caráter by Mario de Andrade and gathered a variety of practitioners and thinkers to explore questions surrounding decolonial curatorial practices and the evolving of museum concepts around care. In particular, the digital workshops held throughout 2021-2022 addressed questions of how a pluralisation of narratives and perspectives can become visible and the role translation, fictionalization and the voids in collections is within museums and their narratives.

Over the course of several digital workshop sessions, the project invited participants to share their thoughts and responses on the subjects of postcolonial curating, translation and fiction and subsequently resulted in the publication of a rich and multilingual compilation of essays, photographs, a poem and a recipe. The contributions are primarily in Portuguese, English and Spanish.
